

## THURAYA – tracking

Three levels of tracking are possible / available:

**ThurayaLocate™** a complimentary service that allows those you wish to view any Thuraya handset being used in the world through maps, satellite images and aerial photography.

**ThurayaRelay™** combines updated positioning services and the ThurayaLocate™ dynamics with a stream of new and useful features such as emergency SOS

**ThurayaAssist™** provides you with access to a spectrum of services when you're on the go both on the road and off the beaten track. With full global 24\*7 voice assistance in emergency or for prior briefing, ThurayaAssist™ is the ultimate in personalised travel SOS services

1. Create an account with either of the two links below:
  - a. <http://www.thurayalocate.com/Login.aspx>
  - b. <http://www.geonixlocate.com/Login/Login.aspx>
2. Add a device.
  - To do this select My Device > either **Add device** or **Add more devices** if you have more than one device.
  - Next select your handset e.g. Thuraya Gen 2 SO-2510
  - Next select Display name, this can be anything you want.
  - Phone number must be your MSISDN number you are using in the handset e.g. +8821652012345
3. Then press **Update**
4. When you change your device Thuraya will email you the device instructions, this will provide the phone number and how to send the GPS location via SMS on that particular handset.
5. Once you have achieved this and sent your location, refer back to the website and select **View History**. (May have to allow POP-up if you are using Internet explorer)
6. Depending how many GPS location you sent will appear on the left hand side. Click the Position History then view your location.
  - The information will display in Google Maps, it is recommended that you have a good Internet connection.
